Prodded by her client, Diane Paparo was inspired to pick the color palette for this project by the color of the client's dog. The result – a sunny, warm, camel color dominated the scheme, balanced by chocolate, pumpkin, and teal.

The striking ceiling height encouraged Paparo to design the bed herself, ensuring the result was of the appropriate scale. The chaise lounge was new, but next to it she placed a sleek, modern antique. "When people think old, they think old and dusty and ornate, but that is not necessarily the case." A signature move for Paparo, the "his and her" sides of the bed were complimentary, but not identical, like two people in a marriage. She accessorized the space with a careful eye to the grand scale of the room, as she explained, "People often misjudge scale. Sometimes all the accessories from one project need to be grouped together as a single accessory in another project."
